

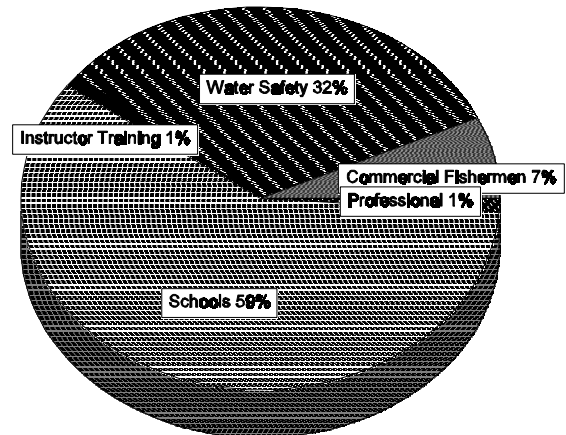
Marine Safety Training Available

AMSEA MARINE SAFETY INSTRUCTOR COURSE

Seward, March 22-27, 1999

AMSEA's 36th US Coast Guard-approved Marine Safety Instructor Trainer Course is appropriate for anyone interested in teaching marine safety to commercial fishermen, school children, recreational boaters or agency personnel. The course includes hands-on use of safety equipment and procedures, methods of instruction, and teaching tips specific to teaching marine and boating safety. Several sets of curriculum for these topics are included. This course is also designed to train those who wish to train commercial fishermen or other professional mariners in AMSEA's USCG approved Drill Instructor course.
